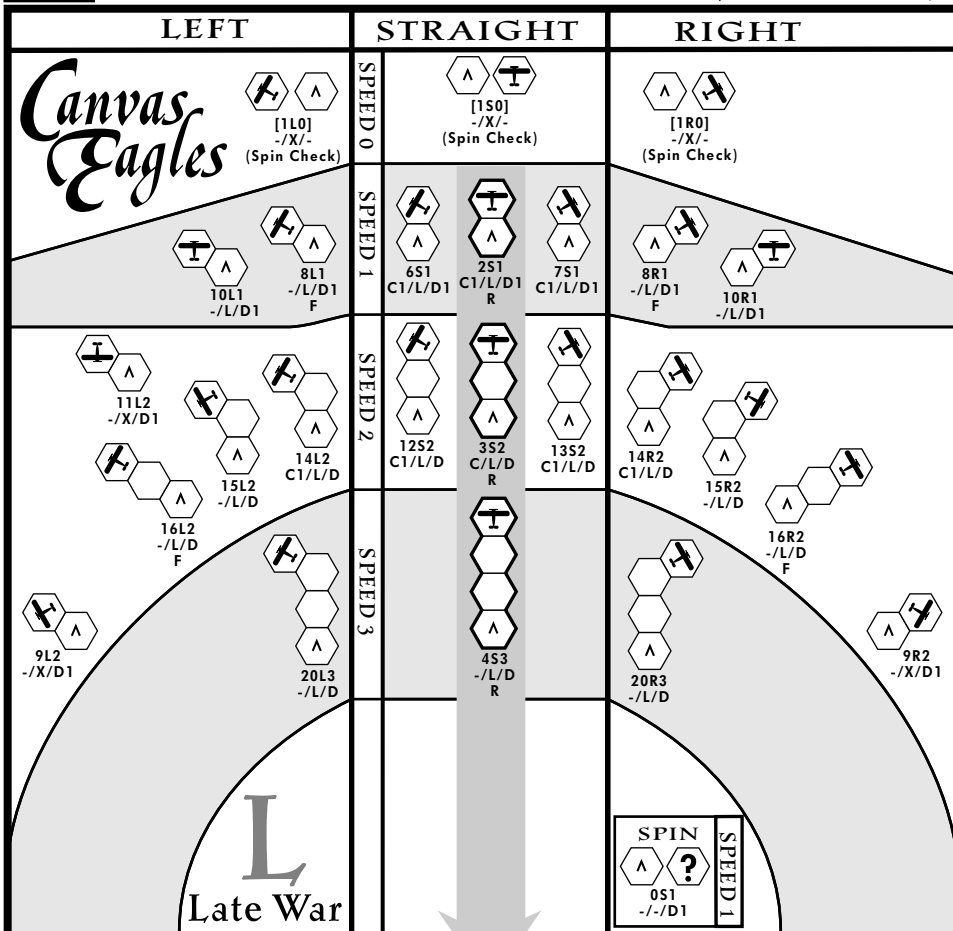


AIRCRAFT MANEUVER SCHEDULE



NOTES:	LEFT	STRAIGHT	RIGHT	FIRE TEMPLATES
	<p>Climbing and performing a 2752 maneuver requires the aircraft to have dived at least 2 altitude levels the previous turn.</p> <p>C= May climb to max. C1= Max climb is 1. D= May dive to max. D1= Max dive is 1. L= May fly level. X= May fly level, but must dive next turn. - = May not perform.</p> <p>R = Aircraft may perform a restricted maneuver the next turn; Pilots may unjam machine gun(s) while aircraft performs one of these maneuvers (no climbing or diving is permitted during attempt). Service: Aug '17 - End: Turkey: Oct '18 - End. Note that a 1918 variant of the Pfalz D-III was equipped with three machine guns; if this variant is chosen, an ammunition limit of 12 ammo boxes MUST be employed. When firing with the triple Spandaus, add +3 to Combat Value for a long burst; +2 for a medium burst; +1 for a short burst.
